The Paralympic Curling Competition in Sochi in 2014 will comprise 10 teams.

Russia, as host, receives an automatic entry. The remaining 9 places will be offered to the 9 National Paralympic Committees of the Member Associations of the World Curling Federation who have gained the most qualifying points from the World Wheelchair Curling Championships (WWhCCs) held in 2011, 2012, and 2013.

Points are awarded according to final ranking of the 10 participating teams in WWhCCs as follows: 12 – 10 – 8 – 7 – 6 – 5 – 4 – 3 – 2 – 1

Teams will be ranked at the WWhCCs, and Paralympic Qualification Points will be awarded, according to the [WCF Rules of Competition C9](#) – Team Ranking Procedure.
